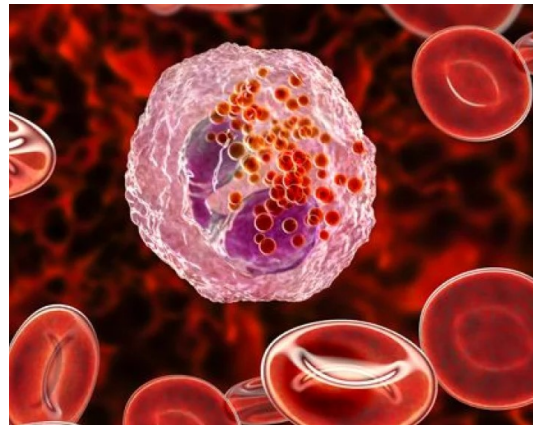


Study: Oxygen Therapy May Slow Alzheimer's

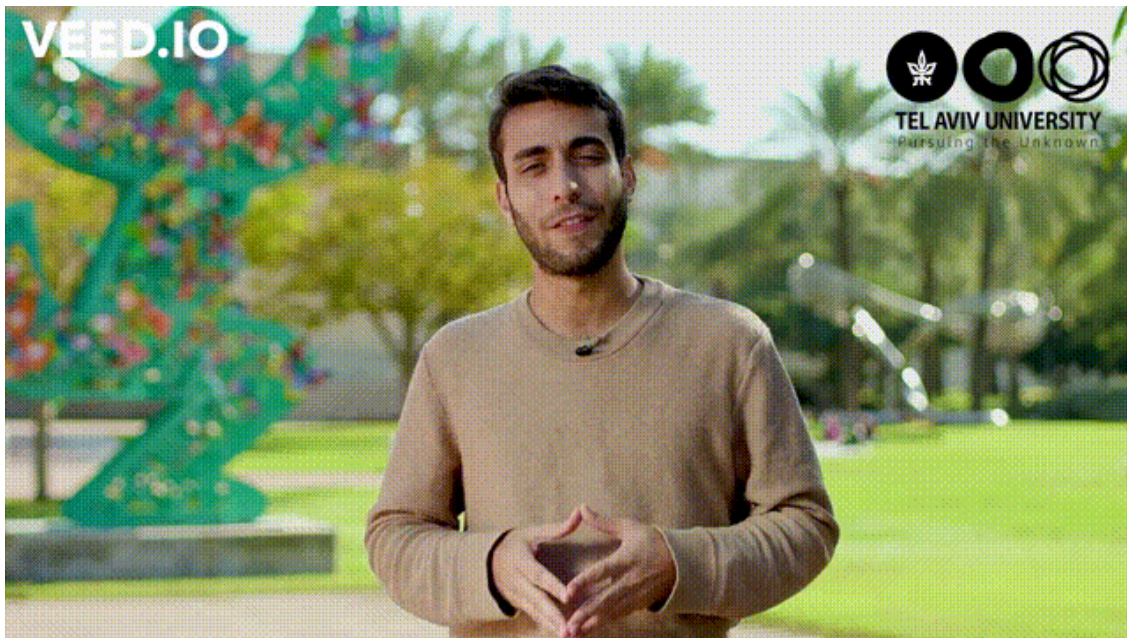
