We are excited that TAU's School of Architecture won a competition to design the Israeli Pavilion at the 2021 London Design Biennale, opening on the 1st of June. This year's Biennale is the first in person international festival to return to the UK after more than a year, and unlike any other year - YOU can be a part of the designing team. How?

The Israeli Pavilion is a multi-sensory experience called 'The Boiler Room', made from 2,500 hashtagged boiler switches, that represent the boiling discourse and the tensions between what is global and what is national. We invite you to turn on a switch, for £10, which will in turn appear in the physical version of the installation at Somerset House, where people from all over the

world will interact with each other's opinions both digitally and personally. The donation of each switch will be used solely to support the installation.


